2. REGISTRATION

Participants may register at a counter located just outside Temasek Room I & II, Level 2 at 1300-1400hrs on 7 June.

3. MEALS

- (b) Breakfast will be served at CafeBiz, Lobby Level.
- (c) Lunch on 7 and 8 June will be served at the CafeBiz, Lobby Level.

4. ACCOMMODATION

Reservations will be made for all foreign participants to stay at the **Traders Hotel**. The net room rate is around **SGD\$270.71** per room per night (inclusive of daily buffet breakfast for one). In accordance with usual CSCAP practice, the host will provide 2-nights' accommodation for one representative per CSCAP member committee. Check-in time is at 1400hrs while check-out time is at 1200hrs. Participants who wish to arrive earlier or remain later should inform CSCAP Singapore well in advance.

5. TRANSPORTATION

Exit from the airport and follow signs to PIE (Pan Island Expressway). Take Exit 15A, onto CTE (City). Continue on CTE (Central Expressway) and exit at Bukit Timah Road (Exit 6). Stay on Bukit Timah Road, turn left at Scotts Road and onto Paterson Road. Turn right at Orchard Boulevard, and right again at Orchard Spring Lane. Finally turn left at Cuscaden Road to the hotel.

6. AIRPORT TAX

For international flights, the airport departure tax is SGD\$28 per person and already included in the cost of the flight ticket.
