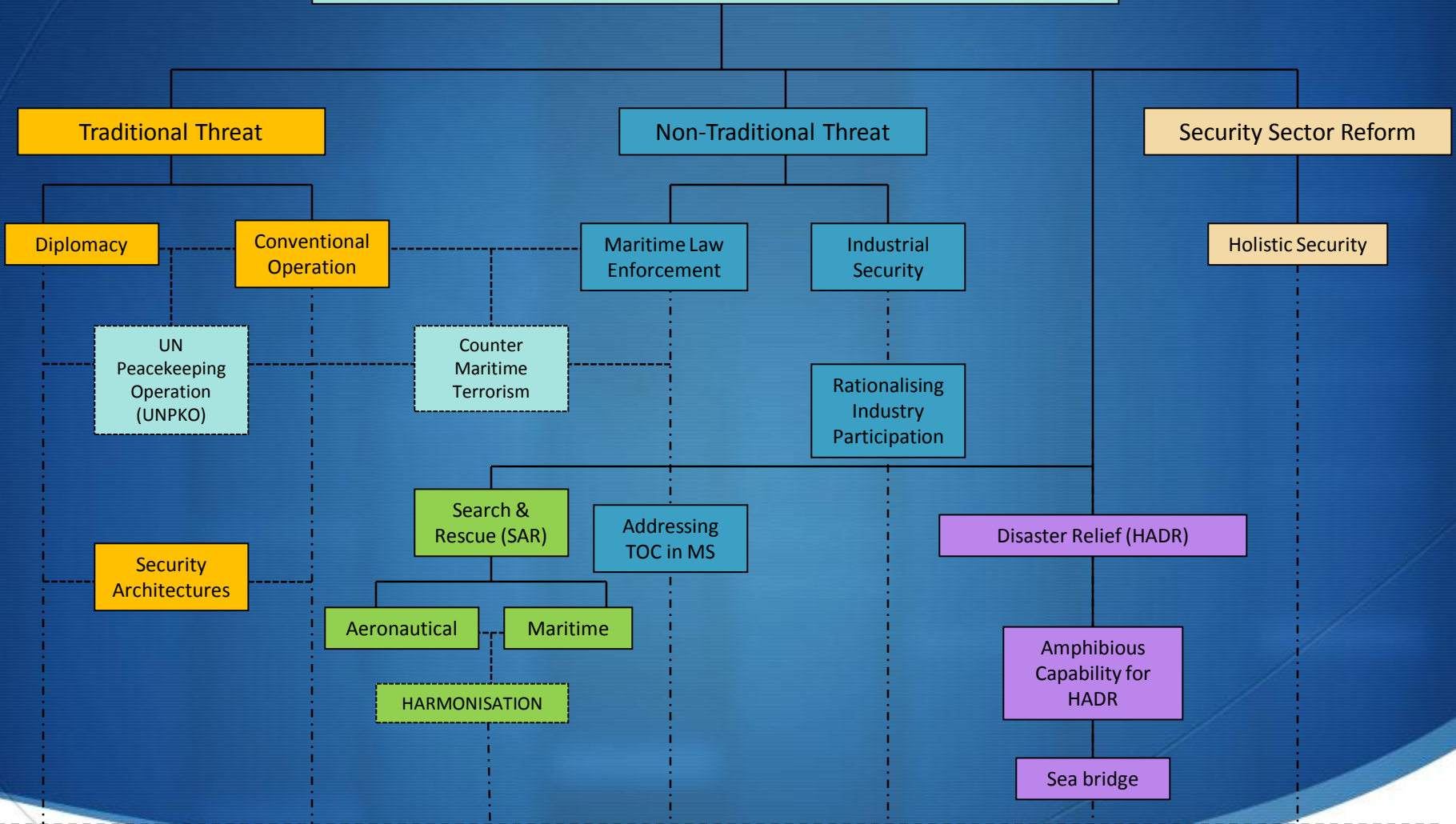

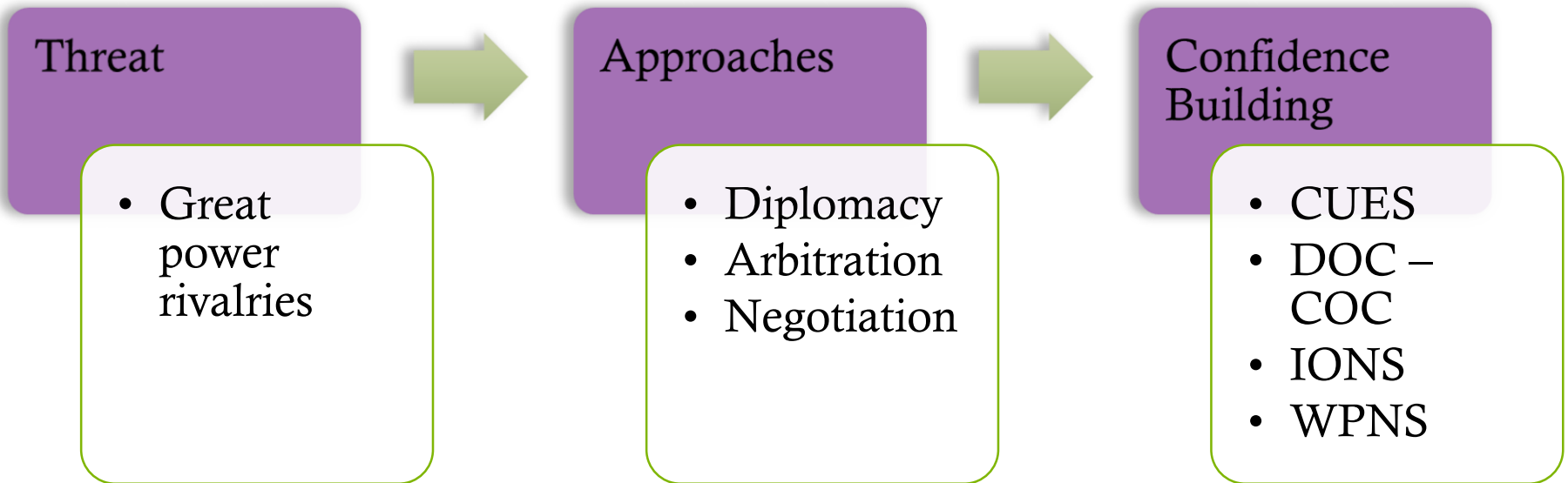

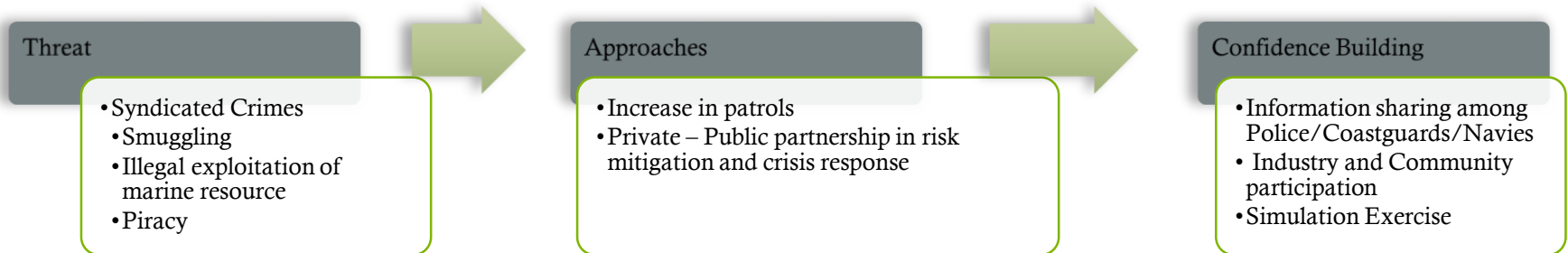
## GOALS

- Enduring Security for Economic Activity.

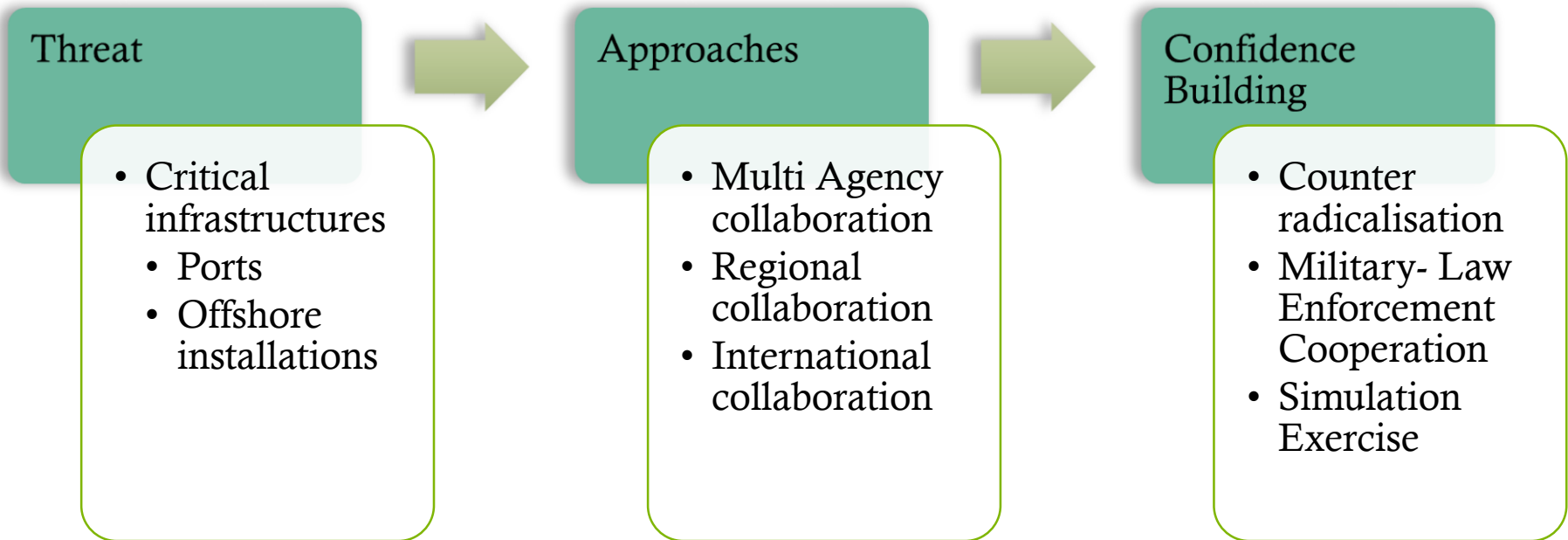

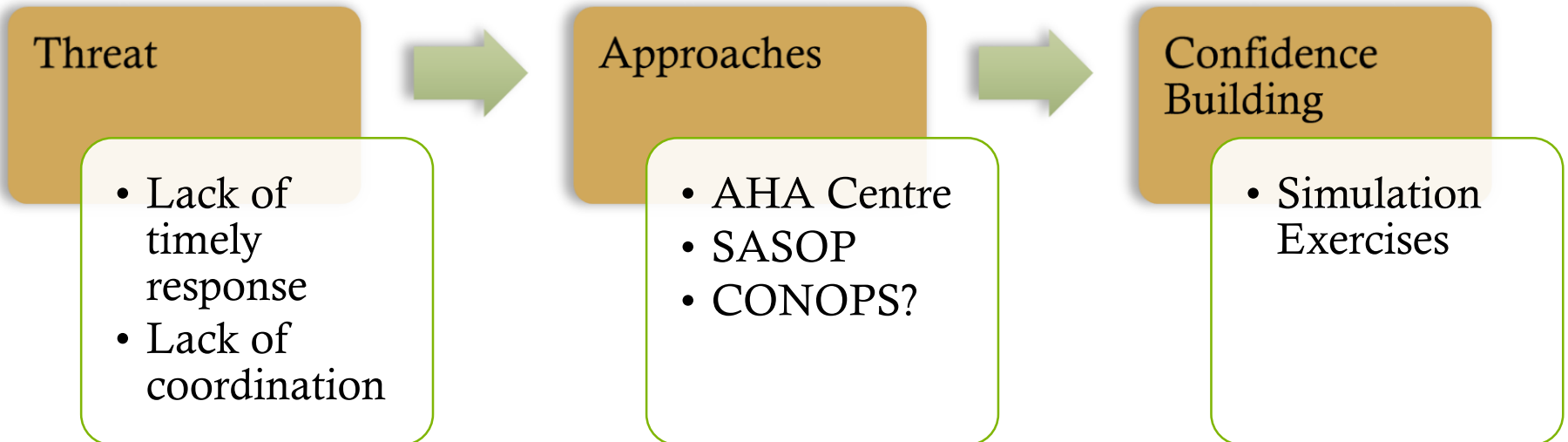

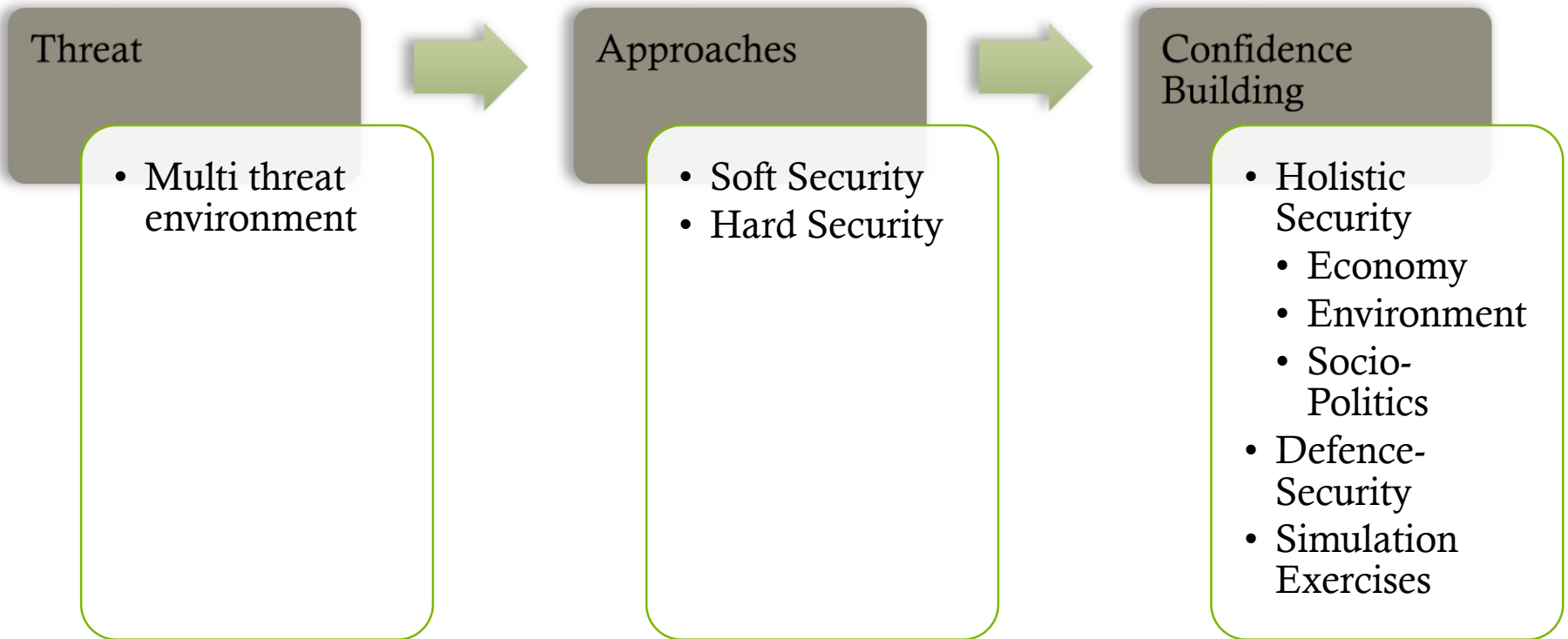
